Someone once said, "I complained because I didn't have any shoes until, I met a man with no legs." Complaining in a Christian's life has to be one of the saddest things on this planet. If we complain about what we can change, then we are a foolish people and if we complain about what we cannot change, then we are complaining against God. If it's good, then we have joy and if it's bad then we want to give up. The Israelites wandered in the wilderness for forty years and never entered into the promise land because of a complaining attitude that bred unbelief. Some say it was only a month journey across the desert to the promise land but because they complained against the provision of God, He let them wander. When the twelve spies were sent to Canaan land to spy out the land, ten brought back an evil report. The people believed the evil report and God refused to let them go across the Jordan to Canaan. 40 years later a new generation had been raised and they went across the Jordan to Canaan to possess the land. Nothing had changed in Canaan land. The report was the same. Then what changed? It was their attitude toward God and His provision for their lives. Heaven has no time for complaining Christians but Heaven is open to those that are thankful for His goodness.
